### How to get to Bergen?

In addition to a large selection of direct flights to Bergen, you can also arrive by ferry or cruise from Hirtshals Denmark, by train from Oslo or by car along the scenic fjords and coast to Bergen. There is also an express bus from Stavanger. Please visit the [visitbergen.com](http://visitbergen.com) website for more information.

### Transport from/to airport

Some of our previous guests were taken by surprise by the high taxi rates in Norway. Hence, we would like to inform you that it is now possible to take the [Light Rail \(Bybanen\)](#) from the airport to the city centre.

Alternatively, the [Airport express bus](#) departs from the airport every 10 minutes. The tour from the airport to the city centre takes approximately 35 minutes.

### How to get to the Faculty of Law

The best way to discover Bergen is by foot. Depending on where you will stay, you may have to walk between 5 and 20 min from your hotel to the Faculty of Law.

The Faculty of Law is located on the hill side of Bergen, just a few steps away from the city centre. It will only take you 10 min to walk up the hill from the city centre.
