University Elections

- Every year **university elections** are held at the university, in which **13 international students** can be elected to the **International Students Parliament (ISP)** for one year
- Elections are held in the form of **lists**. Several students with similar interests can be included on a single list
- This list must be submitted to the electoral register no later than **25th November** before the election
- In the election (typically in **January**), students can then vote for the list that appeals to them
- After the votes have been counted, the 13 seats are **distributed proportionally among the lists** according to the number of votes cast

- Consists of **13 international students**
- **Representing the international student body**, their specific problems and interests towards the university
- Election, discharge and supervision of the **International Students Council (ISC)**
- Decision on a **budget** of up to several thousand euros

- The opportunity to implement your **own ideas** at the university
- Experience in dealing with **democracy** and **parliamentarianism**
- **Lively exchange** with fellow students and new friends
- Issuance of a **certificate** for your CV
- An own office at the AStA for the ISC
