

The prerequisites for M.EP.06a changed in October 2025. Students must now complete either M.EP.04a or M.EP.10d in order to be admitted to modules M.EP.09a and M.EP.06a. Could this cause problems for YOU?

(1) Do you want to write your MA thesis in Anglophone Literature and Culture?

Yes. → Please continue with the next question.

No. → In this case you can stop reading now. No problems!

(2) Did you enrol in your MA ELLC programme in summer semester 2024 or earlier?

Yes. → Please continue with the next question.

(3) Are you currently doing, or planning to do, module M.EP.09a Research Course: Anglophone Literature and Culture?

(This is the 12-credit module with which you prepare for your MA thesis.)

No. → Please continue with the next question.

Yes. → In this case you can stop reading now. No problems!

(4) Have you completed a paper module, or are you currently completing one?

(This refers to M.EP.04a Advanced Anglophone Literature and Culture or M.EP.10d Topics in Anglophone Literature; M.EP.14 Academic Writing and M.EP.01c Anglophone Literature and Culture: Theoretical Foundations do not count.)

No. → Please continue with the next question.

Yes. → In this case you can stop reading now. No problems!

(5) How many credits will you have in your core curriculum at the end of this semester, when all exams are passed and booked?

(This excludes soft skills credits e.g. from German language modules.)

Fewer than 60 credits.

→ No problem. Please note that you must complete either M.EP.04a or M.EP.10d in order to be admitted to modules M.EP.09a and M.EP.06a.

66 credits. I am planning to complete one more module and M.EP.06a in the winter semester.

→ Please contact Dr. Reitemeier.

72 credits. I only need M.EP.06a which I am planning to take in the winter semester.

→ Please contact your thesis supervisor for assistance.
